Nymi Connect for Windows 1.0.5

The strongest use case for the Nymi Band is creation of signatures in applications like Manufacturing Execution Systems (MES). These are commonly used in large pharma manufacturing plants to govern the manufacturing process. The operator frequently must sign off on steps in the process by creating a signature. This is usually done by prompting the operator to enter their username and password.

Nymi terms these applications as **legacy applications** because they are limited to authentication via username and password.

Nymi needs a simple and reliable way to allow users to use the Nymi Band with legacy applications on Windows. Nymi Connect for Windows is a new component that can be added to the Connected Worker Platform (CWP) solution that enables users to login and perform e-signatures with the Nymi Band with minimal application specific training and prerequisites.

In this release, Nymi Connect for Windows supports logins and e-signatures on POMSNet vR400.7 with the Microsoft Edge browser in IE compatibility mode. Support for additional applications and platforms will be added in future releases.

The NCW 1.0.5 is a major release with Risk Level 0. It can be used for use in production deployments or GxP environments.
